Ms. Angela Yvonne Pierce, age 48, passed into rest Saturday, October 9, 2021, at the Duke University Hospital after a courageous battle with breast cancer. The native Statesboro/Bulloch County, Georgia resided in Raleigh, North Carolina.

She received her formal education in the Richmond County School System and was a graduate of Glenn Hills High School. She furthered her education by attending the University of Miami and receiving a Doctorates Degree in Criminal Justice from Capella University and a Master's Degree from Chaminade University.

Ms. Angela Y. Pierce was a member of the Delta Sigma Theta Sorority and attended the Raleigh North Christian Center Church. She was currently employed by The State of North Carolina Department of Public Safety (NCDPS-OSDT)

She leaves to cherish her memories, her mother, Voncille Pierce-Mckie, Augusta, GA; father, Robert Lee Butler, Statesboro, GA; a sister, Andrea Yolanda Pierce, Jonesboro, GA; her grandmother, Minister Norena Pierce, Woodstock, GA; a host of aunts, uncles, other relatives and friends.

“ My words are far too inadequate to express my sorrow in the earthly loss of Angie. We became fast friends as colleagues at the Department of Juvenile Justice (JJ) where I started in June 2018, found that we had a deep connection and quickly started calling each other Sister. Angie was the brightest of lights at JJ and was the catalyst for the formation of a birthday group amongst other likeminded women within our office complex. She was the creative mind behind personalized birthday office decorations and lunch gatherings, and those interactions continue to bring smiles to me to this day.

By January 2020, I'd transferred to another State agency, and Angie and I only had an opportunity to actually see each other again once via a Teams call, but we kept in touch through periodic calls but most often by text. I cherish those brief moments of engagement and am so thankful to retain the history of those communications, particularly an audio text message I've saved from January of this year which I've now saved in multiple avenues to ensure I have access to it always.

I don't have enough space here to expound on all that Angie meant to me. She was a comrade in arms to my daughter who is a cancer survivor, and a voice of reason to aid me in crossing the transitional bridge of communication from my baby boy to that of my now grownish son.

I will miss her smile, laugh and effervescent Spirit, but most of all, our spiritual conversations and prayers to God. She had an unwavering faith, and I trust in my heart of hearts that she transitioned from this plane to the next at Peace.

I regret that I cannot find one picture that we took together, but am sharing here the photo of a blanket I sent to her January of this year that she was sure to add to her audio thank you of receipt. It was my small attempt to tangibly demonstrate she was wrapped in the warmth and love that I carry for her in my heart.

To Angela's family-Thank you for sharing her with us. Though we've never had an opportunity to meet, she spoke of you fondly and I feel I know you well. My condolences and deepest regrets that I will not be able to attend her services, but I shall certainly be with you all in Spirit.
