Deacon Bennie Hart Gordon, Sr., age 98, entered into rest, Monday June 28, 2021 at his residence. He was the son of the late Elisha and Pearl Gordon and received his formal education in the public school system of Screven County.

Deacon Gordon served his country in the United States Army during WWII in Europe with Company A, 41st Signal BN from 1943 to 1945. On September 3, 1946 he united in holy matrimony to the late Elouise Kent Gordon. To this union fourteen children were born.

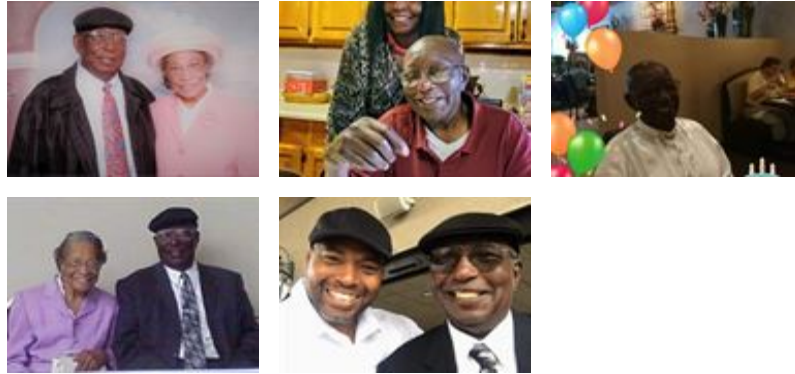
Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, social distancing will be enforced at the funeral home and graveside services. We ask that you adhere to all CDC guidelines.
