Mr. Curtis Frink passed into rest, Saturday morning, February 27, 2016 at the Kindred Hospital, Atlanta, Georgia. The Bulloch County native was the son of the late Hagin and Lillie Mae Frink. He received his formal education in the Bulloch County school system and attended the William James High School.

Mr. Frink retired from Georgia Southern University after forty-six years of service as a food service manager in 2004. During his career at GSU, he received several awards and gifts as well as continuing with the annual summer traditional of water melon slicing after his retirement. Mr. Frink was an active member of the Community Brotherhood Fishing Auxiliary and a member of the Bethlehem Baptist Church.

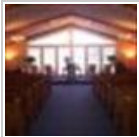
