Atlanta, Ga. - Mr. Curtis Whitfield, age 70, transitioned to eternal rest Wednesday, December 30, 2020, at the Piedmont Henry Hospital in Stockbridge, Georgia following an extended illness.

The Bulloch County native was one of eight children born to Theodore and Pauline Johnson Whitfield. He received his formal education in the Bulloch County School System. Curtis was employed by Blackstone Foundry (later ITT Grinnell) before moving to Orlando, Florida and thereafter Atlanta, where he labored in construction until retirement.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Pauline and Theodore Whitfield and a sister who would have been the eldest of the Whitfield children had she survived childbirth.
