Deacon Doy Johnson was born on February 8, 1956, to John Henry and Irene Lee Johnson. He received his formal education in the Bulloch County School System.

He accepted Christ as his lord and savior at an early age and remained active in his faith until his health declined. He was a member of the Whitesville Full Gospel Worship Center under the leadership of Bishop Larry and Pastor Gwendolyn Jones.
