



Reverend Felicia Letrice Atkinson-Fowler

Reverend Felicia "Letrice" Atkinson-Fowler was born on November 20, 1972, in Metter, Georgia, to Seth Atkinson and Ruby Faye Perry. She received her education in the public schools of Bulloch County and later obtained her GED from Ogeechee Technical College. Before her health declined, she was employed by Transdev in Kennesaw, Georgia.

At a young age, Reverend Atkinson-Fowler professed her faith in Jesus Christ and became a member of Whitesville Baptist Church, commencing a lifelong commitment to spiritual service. Subsequently, she answered the call to ministry and was ordained as a minister. She served as pastor of Jerusalem AME Church with dedication, exemplifying compassion, strength, and steadfast faith. At the time of her passing, she was an active member of Greater Gaines Chapel in Savannah, Georgia.

Beyond her preaching, Reverend Atkinson-Fowler had a profound appreciation for music and participated in ministry through song. A talented vocalist, she performed alongside her family members for many years. Following her father's passing, she joined the Gospel Miracles singing group,

composing notable songs including the theme “Stand Up and Praise His Name.”

She later spent time in New York where she worked on her album, “I Don’t Wanna Play Church No More.” During this period, she attended Christ Cultivated Community Church under the guidance of Apostle Mitchell (Syracuse, NY), continuing to develop her faith and ministry.

On Wednesday, February 11, 2026, Reverend Felicia “Letrice” Atkinson-Fowler passed away peacefully at her mother’s residence. She was a devoted wife, daughter, mother, sister, aunt, cousin, and friend whose wisdom, compassion, and prayers positively impacted many lives.

She was predeceased by her father, Seth Atkinson; her sister, Verlene Atkinson; her brothers, Robin Atkinson, Bobby Atkinson, and Seth Atkinson Jr.; and both maternal and paternal grandparents.

Her memory is honored by her husband, Carnell Fowler; her mother, Ruby Faye Perry of Register, Georgia; her children, Jaric Atkinson (Kyrie) of Long Beach, California, Shaquana Atkinson of Smyrna, Georgia, Samaria Atkinson (Antonio) of Statesboro, Georgia; siblings Jackie (Harry) of Macon, Georgia, Billy (Faye) of Macon, Georgia, Tyrone (Brandy) of Claxton, Georgia, Damita Atkinson of Register, Georgia, and Shakina (James) of Ft.
