The Reverend John Wesley Hunter, Sr., age 64, departed this life Tuesday, November 23, 2021 at the East Georgia Regional Medical Center.

John W. Hunter Sr. was born on June 2, 1957 to Virginia Hunter McCrae and the late Eddie Wright in Sylvania Georgia. He was a graduate of Brewton Parker College, where he received a degree in Theology and Christian studies. He served in the United States Army.

Reverend Hunter resided in Bulloch County for the last 30 years, where he established a youth outreach program Mission for Christ. He was an entrepreneur and former restaurant owner of The Big Apple. Later, he became a social worker for the elderly and worked as a social service administrator.

He leaves to cherish his memories: his wife of 43 years, Katherine Hunter; his mother, Virginia McCrae; three children, Angela Hunter, John Hunter, Jr. and Clifford Hunter; two grandchildren, Alexis Hunter and John Hunter, III; two sisters, Tracy Owens and Penny Wright; two brothers, Eugene Wright and Lavon Wright; three aunts, Eloise Wilson, Daisy Taylor and Eula Miles; two uncles, Roscoe Hunter and Joe Hunter; a host of other relatives and friends.

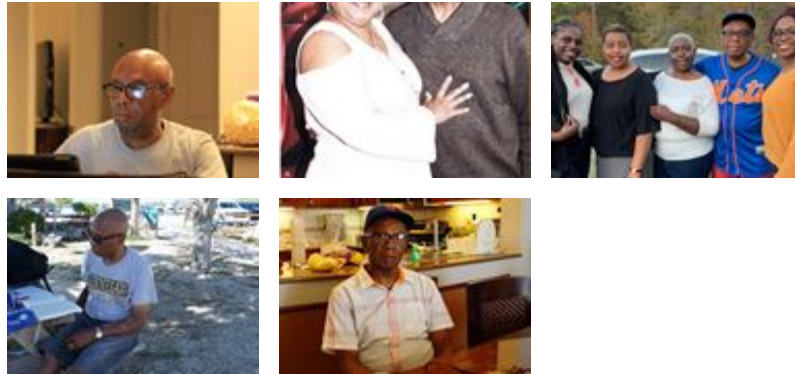

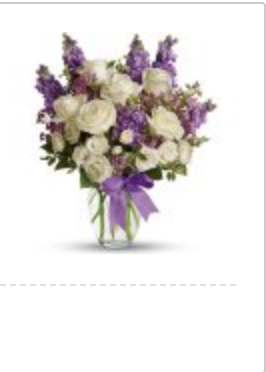
