He received his formal education in the public school system of Bulloch County and was a graduate of the of the Statesboro High School Class of 1985. Kevin furthered his education at Morris Brown College and later received a business degree from Georgia Southern University in 1992.

In 2019 Kevin and his wife Charlene created a support group, "The You are Not Alone Support Group, Inc.".
