Final rites have been entrusted to Hill's Mortuary, Inc.

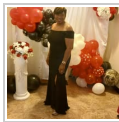

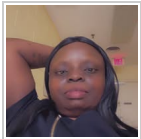

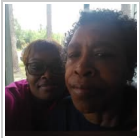
