Ms. Mamie Lee Bryant, age 70, passed into rest, Friday December 24, 2021 at the Landmark Hospital in Savannah, Georgia. She was born in Screven County, Georgia to the late Joseph and Nora Miller.

She received her formal education in the Screven County School System and briefly attended Ogeechee Technical College.

Ms. Mamie Bryant was a retired employee of Georgia Southern University, where she worked from 1998 to 2011.
