Mrs. Marvenia Griffin Campbell age 78, passed into eternal rest, Thursday, July 14, 2016 at the Optim Medical Center. The Screven County native received her formal education in the public school system of Screven County and was the daughter of the late Johnny and Frankie Mae Bates Ingram. She was a member of the Lewis Chapel C.M.E Church where she served as a church Stewardess and President of the Missionary Board until her health failed.

Mrs. Campbell retired as the Center Director for 34 years of the Central Savannah River Area (CSRA) Community Service Agency, she served as a community activist to help people gain employment, secured housing for senior citizens, wrote grants for seniors to have their homes renovated, served as youth coordinator, assisted citizens with securing emergency rental assistance, and she continually served as a guiding force for the community while serving on planning groups, local campaigns, and advocating for preservation and development in underserved neighborhoods.

Mrs. Marvenia Campbell also worked with local governments and represented the Department of Community Affairs on behalf of the Equal Opportunity Agency (EOA) to lead the initiative to secure the present location of the Neighborhood Service/Senior Center in Sylvania, Georgia. As a result her

dedication, she received numerous civic and political awards and traveled extensively throughout the United States. Additionally, she served as a member of the Inter Agency Council, Elderly Abuse Council, and the NAACP to better the lives of the citizens of Sylvania, GA.
