Reverend Willie Hall, Jr., age 89, passed away Thursday, June 12, 2025, at the East Georgia Regional Medical Center after a brief illness. He was born. February 13, 1936 the third of ten children, born to the Willie and Gussie Ward Hall.

He received his education in the Bulloch County School system and graduated from William James High School in 1955. He served in the United States Army for three years after being drafted. After his discharge, Willie moved to Fort Lauderdale, Florida and began working in construction, a career he pursued throughout his life, often collaborating with relatives.

While in Fort Lauderdale, he met and married his wife Alberta Hannah in 1988. He later became a licensed and ordained minister and founded the New Resurrection Pentecostal Ministries Church, Inc. with his wife Alberta. He served as Pastor and she was Co-Pastor, focusing on both spiritual and physical community service.

Years later, he was ordained as Bishop and continued his ministry for 35 years. Rev. Hall eventually returned to Bulloch County, reconnecting with his family and the Johnson Grove Missionary Baptist church. He was a devoted

member of the Community Benefit Outreach Mission.

In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death, five siblings, Roosevelt Hall, Jim Hall (Mauestine), John Hall, Fred Hall (Ruthie Mae) and Lucille Montgomery (Willie), his wife, Alberta Hall, a daughter, Carol Burgess and a stepson, Vernon Alford.

He leaves to cherish his memories his children, Wayne Parrish of Salt Lake City, Ut, and Paula Hall of Fort Lauderdale, Fl; step children, Dennis Alford and Dolphin Alford; his siblings, Margaret Lanier (Bobby Ray-deceased) of Portal, GA, Nelrose Reese (Rev. David L. Reese-deceased) of Millen, GA, Alice Smith (Raymond) Fort Lauderdale, FL, and Frank Hall of Kissimmee, FL, 4 grandchildren and several great-grandchildren, a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

The Hall family will receive visitors on Friday, June 20, 2025, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the Ben Samuel Hill memorial Chapel of Hill's Mortuary.

The funeral service for Rev. Willie Hall, Jr., will be held at 11 A.M., Saturday, June 21, 2025, at the Johnson Grove Missionary Baptist Church with the Elder Donald Chavers, Jr., presiding and the pastor, Rev. S. Maurice Hill, officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery with military honors.
